Bereavement support for people over 50, delivered in Beauchief and Greenhill ward.

Well-being practitioners

Start Up

Support and up to £200 for people over 50 to start up their own activity, delivered in Burngreave, Firth Park, Woodhouse and Beauchief and Greenhill wards.

Travel advice and support for people over 50 living in the Firth Park ward.

Live Better, Get Connected

A community based service for people over 50 living in Beauchief and Greenhill ward who find financial hardship to be a barrier to accessing health and wellbeing support and advice.
